Our purpose is to make the Lord Jesus Christ a reality in the lives of people.

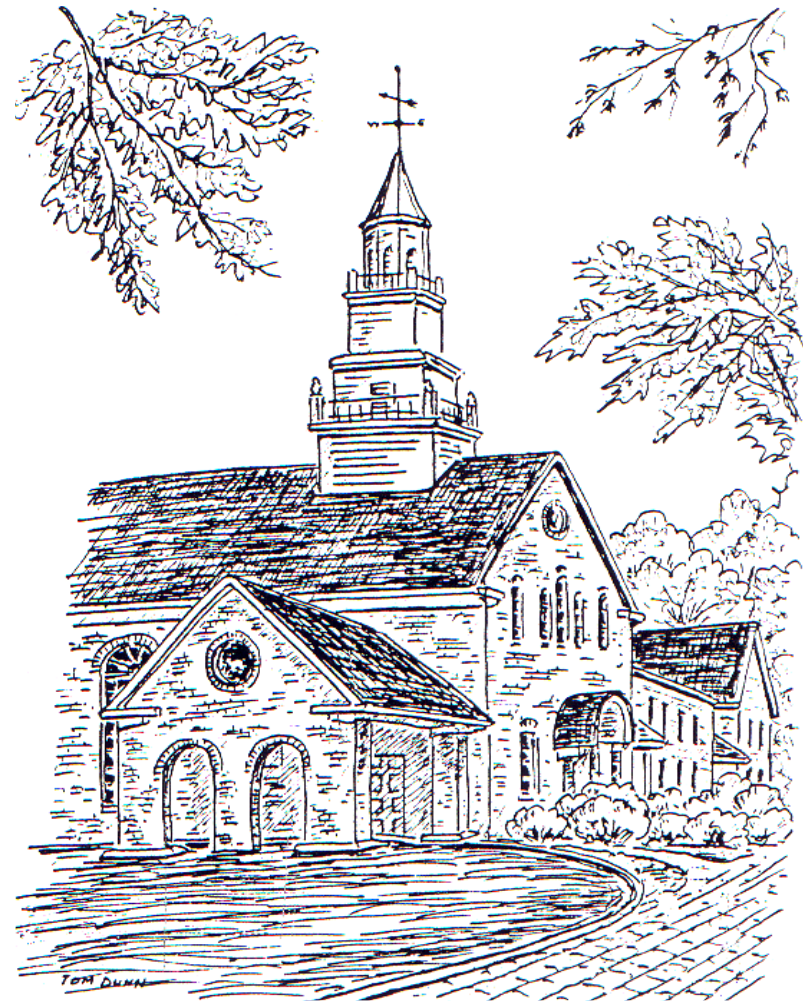
**To you, O Lord, I cried,
