Crisis Control is collecting baking items as their gift of the month for November. If you would like to help, please leave items on the table beside the mailboxes. They appreciate your generosity.

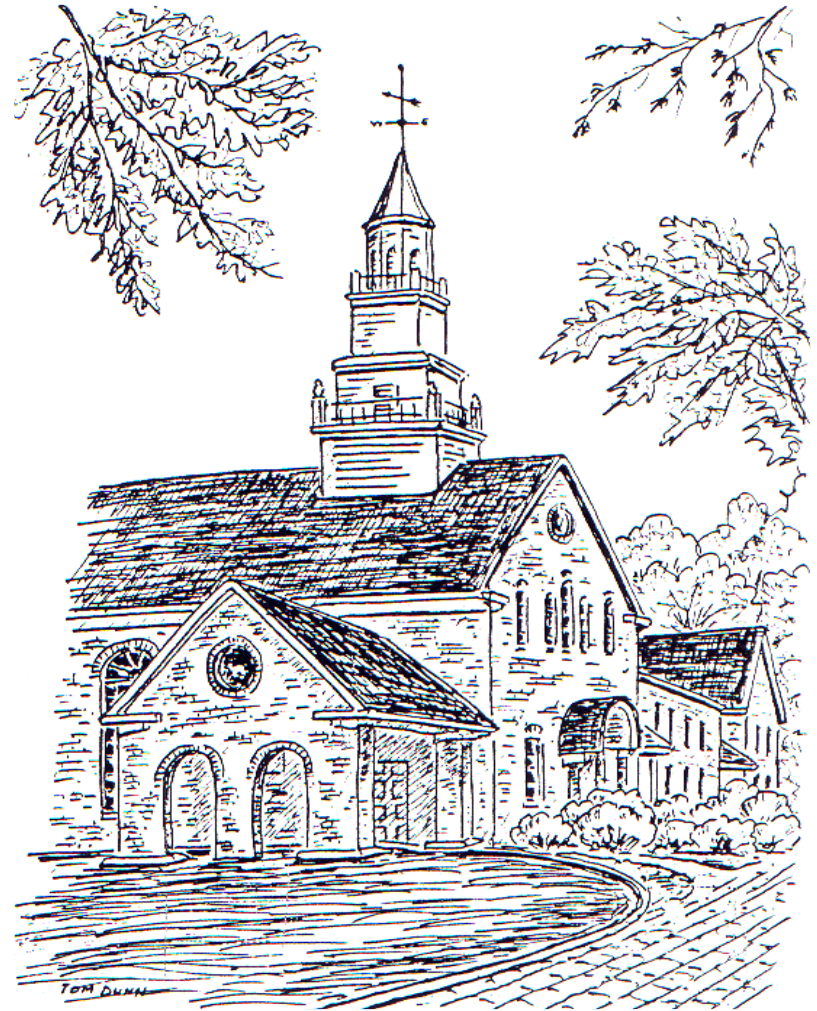
